


Overall, I consider security a necessary service.


<u>**1** strongly disagree; **2** disagree; **3** neutral/indifferent; **4** agree; and **5** strongly agree</u>

I consider the security costs reasonable.





checks.




I think monitoring and evaluating homeowners' compliance with community regulations (CC&R's) is a necessary contracted service that I'm willing to pay for.

I think notifying me that my garage door is open is a necessary service and I'm willing to trade patrol time for my garage door notifications.






I'm satisfied with approximately 60% of my annual HOA dues going to contracted security services.


I am satisfied with the timeliness of the response of Community Safety Patrol.
